APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED ON FORMS OTHER THAN THOSE PRESCRIBED BY THE OSA WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

All Applications for Exemption from Audit are subject to review and approval by the Office of the State Auditor

Proprietary Activity should be reported on the Cash or Budgetary Basis -- A Budget to GAAP reconciliation is provided in Part 3

Failure to file an application or denial of the request could cause the local government to lose its exemption from audit for that year and the ensuing year.

Governmental Activity should be reported on the Modified Accrual Basis

In that event, AN AUDIT SHALL BE REQUIRED.

Approval for an exemption from audit is granted only upon the review by the OSA.
